EVENTITY® is a prescription medicine used to treat osteoporosis in women after menopause who are at high risk of fracture, or cannot use another osteoporosis medicine or other osteoporosis medicines did not work well.



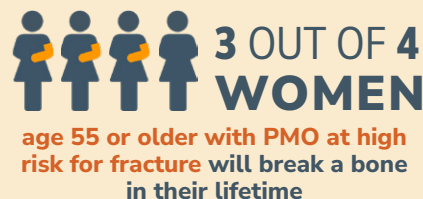
DISCUSSING YOUR FRACTURE RISK AND TREATMENT OPTIONS

Tips for talking with your doctor about building new bone with EVENTITY®—
the first and only bone builder that also helps slow bone loss.

DETERMINE YOUR FRACTURE RISK

ASK YOUR DOCTOR:

- Do I have any risk factors that increase my chance of breaking a bone due to my postmenopausal osteoporosis (PMO)?
- In the next year, how likely am I to break a bone due to my postmenopausal osteoporosis?
- Do I need a bone density scan? (called a DXA scan)
- Do I need medication if I haven't had any symptoms?



You can't always feel your fracture risk worsening. With postmenopausal osteoporosis, bone loss happens without symptoms.

UNDERSTAND YOUR TREATMENT OPTIONS

ASK YOUR DOCTOR:

- Is there more than one way to treat the bone loss caused by my postmenopausal osteoporosis?
- What's the difference between building new bone and slowing bone loss?
- How is EVENTITY different from other osteoporosis treatments?



If you're at very high risk for fracture, **starting with a bone building treatment is recommended to rapidly increase bone mineral density and reduce fracture risk.***

*The 2024 American Society for Bone and Mineral Research/Bone Health and Osteoporosis Foundation (ASBMR/BHOF) position statement on goal-directed osteoporosis treatment recommends anabolic therapy as initial treatment for patients at very high risk for fracture, guided by BMD and fracture history, to rapidly maximize BMD and reduce fracture risk. This position statement represents the consensus of the ASBMR/BHOF Task Force on goal-directed osteoporosis treatment, based on interpretation of the best evidence available. The position statement is not a clinical guideline.

Important Safety Information

What is the most important information I should know about EVENTITY?

EVENTITY can cause serious side effects, including increased risk of having a heart attack, stroke, or death from a cardiovascular (heart or blood vessel) problem. Call your healthcare provider or get emergency help right away if you have any of these symptoms: symptoms of heart attack, which may include: chest pain or pressure; shortness of breath; feeling light-headed or dizzy; or symptoms of stroke, which may include: headache; numbness or weakness in face, arm, or legs; difficulty talking; changes in vision or loss of balance. Before you receive EVENTITY, tell your healthcare provider if you have had a heart attack or stroke, especially if it has happened in the past year.

Each EVENITY dose consists of 2 shots given under your skin every month by your doctor or healthcare provider.

A CLOSER LOOK AT WHAT SETS EVENITY APART

Commonly prescribed osteoporosis treatments work in one of two ways: antiresorptives slow down bone loss, while anabolics help to stimulate new bone formation. EVENITY works in two ways to do both.

Knowing your fracture risk is the first step in finding the most appropriate treatment. **It's important to talk to your doctor about which factors in your life could increase your risk of breaking a bone.**



Don't wait to lower your fracture risk. Ask your doctor if EVENITY can help.

NOTES:

*In a clinical study that followed over 7,000 women with postmenopausal osteoporosis receiving EVENITY or placebo (a treatment without medicine) for 12 months, women receiving EVENITY had fewer new spine fractures than women receiving placebo at 12 months. Reductions in fractures other than spine were not significant at 12 months.

Important Safety Information (cont.)

Do not receive EVENITY if you: have low blood calcium; or are allergic to romosozumab or any of the ingredients in EVENITY.

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Do not receive EVENITY if you: have low blood calcium; or are allergic to romosozumab or any of the ingredients in EVENITY.

Before receiving EVENITY, tell your healthcare provider about all your medical conditions, including if you:

- have a history of other heart or blood vessel problems
- have low blood calcium
- cannot take daily calcium and vitamin D
- have kidney problems or are on kidney dialysis
- plan to have dental surgery or teeth removed

What are the possible side effects of EVENITY?

EVENITY may cause serious side effects, including:

Serious allergic reactions have happened in people who receive EVENITY. Call your healthcare provider or go to the nearest emergency room right away if you have any symptoms of a serious allergic reaction including: rash; hives; swelling of the face, lips, mouth, tongue, or throat which may cause difficulty in swallowing or breathing.

Low calcium levels in your blood (hypocalcemia). EVENITY may lower the calcium levels in your blood. Your low blood calcium should be treated before you receive EVENITY. Call your healthcare provider if you have symptoms of low blood calcium such as: spasms, twitches, or cramps in your muscles; numbness or tingling in your fingers, toes or around your mouth.

Severe jaw bone problems (osteonecrosis) may occur. Your healthcare provider should examine your mouth before you start EVENITY and may tell you to see your dentist. Ask your healthcare provider or dentist about good mouth care.

Unusual thigh bone fractures. Symptoms of this type of fracture include new or unusual pain in your hip, groin, or thigh.

The most common side effects of EVENITY include joint pain and headaches.
